



PRELIMINARY CAMPAIGN EXPENSE LIMITS

What am I allowed to spend on my campaign?

Please refer to the "**Candidates Financial Reporting**" document in your information package.

There are Limits on the amount a candidate may spend during the campaign period. The limit on campaign expenses is based on a formula related to the number of electors entitled to vote for the office:

Mayoralty Candidates	\$7,500 + 85 cents per elector
Councillor Candidates	\$5,000 + 85 cents per elector
School Board Candidates	\$5,000 + 85 cents per elector entitled to vote for that office

For your reference only - the following chart lists the estimated campaign expense formula based on the 2010 Voter's List. Please note that these figures will change as additions and deletions are made to the list up to Nomination Day. The Clerk will issue an Official Certificate of Final Campaign Spending Limits by September 22, 2014 (ten (10) days after Nomination Day) as required by Section 76(7) of the Municipal Elections Act)
