Amendment to By-Law No 2249/84

Amended By-Law Governing Business Operations in Iroquois Falls

On Monday, August 12th, Council for the Town of Iroquois Falls approved an amendment to By-Law No. 2249/84, which required all hawkers, peddlers, and merchants to obtain a license before selling or offering goods within the municipality.

To clarify, hawkers and peddlers are mobile vendors who temporarily set up at various locations or a particular site to sell goods, wares, or merchandise.

The newly amended By-law No. 3801/24 continues to require a license for hawking, peddling, or selling goods within the Municipality of Iroquois Falls. The cost for this license is set at \$100 and is valid from the date of issue until December 31st of that year. Starting January 1st, 2025, annual renewals will cost \$35.

Steps to Apply for Your License:

- 1. Complete an application form at Town Hall, including a full description of the goods, wares, and/or merchandise you intend to sell in the Municipality of Iroquois Falls.
- 2. Pay the \$100 license fee.
- 3. Submit a written letter of permission from the property owner where you plan to sell your goods.
- 4. If you plan to operate from a specific location, obtain a report from the Town's Planning Department confirming compliance with all applicable provisions of the Town's Zoning By-law, including land use and other municipal regulations.
- 5. Provide any additional documentation as required by the Town.
